WOODCREEK SOBER GRAD NITE 2020 STUDENT BEHAVIOR AND CONSEQUENCE AGREEMENT

(Student MUST initial each line)

I understand that if I choose NOT to attend Grad Nite, I will NOT BE ISSUED A REFUND unless my seat can be filled.

- I understand I need to check in at WHS's main parking lot by 10:30pm on our designated departure date.
- I will **not** bring or consume alcohol or any other drugs or tobacco to Grad Nite. I understand there is **NO** food or drink allowed at check-in nor on the bus other than what is provided by Grad Nite chaperones *(this includes WATER BOTTLES, GUM, AND MINTS).*
- I will **not** bring any non-essential medications of any kind (including Advil or Tylenol) to Grad Nite. I understand that a *parent/guardian must drop-off any medications needed in original packaging to my Grad Nite chaperone.* I understand that I can only *BRING THE AMOUNT NEEDED ON TRIP!*
- NO wallets, purses, handbags, etc. are allowed. ALL personal effects will be brought in a clear bag and will be thoroughly searched.
- I will not leave the designated bus boarding area OR get off bus after being check-in.
- All belongings will be emptied out AND examined BOTH AT WOODCREEK AND DISNEYLAND.
- Grad Nite chaperones and volunteers, bus drivers, and Disneyland employees are *not* **responsible** for lost or stolen valuables.
- I will abide by dress code established by Disneyland AND I will wear my WHS Grad Nite T-Shirt (un-altered) for the duration of the trip.
- I agree and understand that I will not leave Disneyland or California Adventure for any reason.
- I understand that I must return to my original bus after Grad Nite for the trip back to Woodcreek and I am responsible for being **ON TIME** (There is a small grace period, and then the buses will leave).
- I will follow any and all rules/guidelines set forth by my bus driver and Grad Nite chaperones.
 - I agree to enhanced security searches at WHS and Disneyland. This includes, but is not limited to, a body pat down performed by an adult of the same sex, a shoe removal check, and a thorough search of all personal items allowed on the buses.
- I understand that if I am not allowed to participate in WHS's Graduation Ceremony, I will NOT be allowed to attend Sober Grad Nite.
- I understand that my parent/guardian named on my registration packet will be contacted to pick me up, if deemed necessary by a Grad Nite chaperone or Disneyland personnel, from Woodcreek High School, Disneyland in Anaheim, CA or anywhere in between those two locations.
- I understand that if I do not follow ALL of these guidelines, I will NOT BE ABLE TO ATTEND WHS SOBER GRAD NITE and I will NOT BE ISSUED A REFUND.

Release, Waiver and Discharge. WOODCREEK SOBER GRAD NITE 2020 DISNEY REQUIRED FORM

PARK HOURS

Participants will arrive at a pre-designated time and may park hop during this time. However, student participants must be inside California Adventure Park by 9:00pm when Disneyland Resort Grad Nite begins. At this time, the gates will be locked and no student participants will be allowed in or out of the California Adventure Park.

DRESS CODE

All apparel must be in good condition (excessively ripped or torn jeans, shirts, etc. are prohibited) and extremely revealing clothing is not allowed.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

• Pets (service animals are permitted and must be wearing an identifying assistive companion vest; pets may be kept at the on-site kennel)

- Wagons
- Skateboards
- Scooters (motorized and non-motorized)
- Inline skates
- Shoes with built-in wheels
- Bicycles
- Motorcycles
- Tricycles
- Unicycles
- Pogo Sticks
- 2-wheeled vehicles, including Segway Human Transporters
- Strollers larger than 36"x 52"
- Suitcases, backpacks, or similar bags with wheels
- Suitcases, backpacks or similar bags larger than 18' wide x 25' high x37' deep (the size of large rentable lockers at the park)

• Any trailer-like object that is pushed or towed by an ECV, wheelchair or stroller *Note: Guests are not permitted to pull items behind them. Any item that requires a Guest to pull it behind him or her, including a stroller, is not permitted into the theme parks.

- Alcoholic Beverages
- Any illegal substances
- Folding chairs, with the exception of cane-chair and seat-walker mobility aids
- Glass containers with the exception of small perfume bottles
- Costumes on guests older than age 9, except during special events that permit children up to age 12 to wear costumes
- Water pistols, toy guns and replica weapons with the exception of those sold in the Disneyland® Resort

• Sporting goods or equipment (e.g., baseball bats, helmets, hockey sticks, golf clubs, bows and arrows, camping equipment, chairs, stools, tables and Frisbees)

- Weapons of any kind (including guns, knives, bully clubs, brass knuckles, nunchucks, stars and other martial arts equipment)
- Self-defense equipment (pepper spray, mace, stun guns)
- Restraining devices (e.g., handcuffs, zip ties) or any suspicious items (e.g., box cutters, razor blades, duct tape, wire)
- Items that may be disruptive (e.g., laser pointers, slingshots, stink bombs, air horns)
- Cremated remains (e.g., urns, vases, boxes)
- Miscellaneous other items (tools, fire extinguishers, musical instruments, megaphones, pots, pans)

- Folding tripod stands that can fit inside a standard backpack are permitted
